

Alps-Adriatic Bachelor Scholarships of Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt

<p>General Information</p>	<p>Located in the Austrian state of Carinthia at the intersection of three cultures, Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt is a center of knowledge acquisition and transfer for the whole Alps-Adriatic region and beyond. Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt strives towards increasing cultural diversity and is highly committed to future development on an international level.</p> <p>The <i>Alps-Adriatic Bachelor Scholarships</i> are awarded to highly qualified high-school graduates from third countries of the extended Alps-Adriatic region¹ who wish to pursue a Bachelor's degree programme² at Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt.</p> <p>Following an international call for applications, the best candidates will be selected in a multi-stage process involving a selected scholarship commission of the respective area of expertise.</p> <p>Alps-Adriatic scholarship holders will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain access to excellent higher education opportunities in an international study environment; • Become part of a vibrant international campus; • Join the international alumni network of Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt.
<p>Target group</p>	<p>Applicants must meet the requirements for admission to the selected Bachelor's degree programme at Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt and must be able to prove that they have either very good German or English language skills³ (depending on the target study programme). Given a sufficient number of applications, a balanced ratio of both male and female applicants will be considered.</p>
<p>Countries of origin</p>	<p>Applicants must be citizens of one of the following third countries of the extended Alps-Adriatic region (in the EU priority region Western Balkans):</p> <p>Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Montenegro, and Serbia.</p> <p>The applicants' place of residence at the time of application must be in a country other than Austria.</p>
<p>Target country</p>	<p>Austria</p>
<p>Scholarship</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monthly scholarship in the amount of EUR 500,- • Funded period per academic year: October to July (10 months) • Scholarship period: max. 2 academic years (20 months) • One-time lump sum for travel costs: between EUR 135,- and EUR 225,-⁴ • Scholarship holders will be exempted from paying tuition fees for a maximum of 7 semesters in the case of proven academic performance. <p>Scholarship holders will receive assistance by the International Office of Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt in applying for student health insurance in Austria. They can also attend a German semester course at a reduced fee.</p>
<p>Authority awarding the scholarship</p>	<p>Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt in cooperation with sponsors.</p>
<p>Quota</p>	<p>Each academic year a total of 15 scholarships are awarded to highly qualified prospective Bachelor students. Due to the regional demand for specialists in the field of information and communication technology (ICT), 7 of the 15 scholarships are awarded to prospective students of the Faculty of Technical Sciences.</p>

<p>Scholarship application procedure</p>	<p>The application for the scholarship must contain the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Convincing letter of application in German or English, depending on the language of instruction of the selected Bachelor's degree programme (cover letter including a letter of motivation) ✓ Curriculum vitae in German or English, depending on the language of instruction of the selected Bachelor's degree programme ✓ Completed application form for admission to the selected Bachelor's degree programme at Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt ✓ Half-yearly school certificate/grades from the current school year or the last available certificate from the previous year ✓ Scan of passport (data page with name and photo) ✓ Two letters of recommendation from teachers from the school that applicants have/will complete/d with attached translation into German or English (stamped by the school) <p>The complete application documents for the scholarship must be submitted electronically to alpenadria.grants@aau.at by 31.05.2019.</p> <p>Please note that incomplete applications will not be taken into consideration.</p>
<p>Selection Procedure</p>	<p>The selection procedure consists of the following phases:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Verification of formal requirements (2) Evaluation of the applications by a scholarship commission (3) Granting of scholarships <p>Please note: The scholarship can be awarded only in combination with the admission to the degree programme at Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt stated in the Letter of Award. The formal fulfilment of all application requirements does not imply any legal entitlement to financial support. Funding will be awarded on the basis of competition and available funds.</p>
<p>Admission application procedure</p>	<p>The application for admission to the Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt must contain the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Proof of high-school achievement (e.g. school certificate), original documents issued by the attended school with attached certified translation into German or English⁵ ✓ Special university entrance qualification ("eligibility letter") to the selected Bachelor's degree programme issued by a state or state-recognised university in the country of issue of the maturity certificate with attached certified translation into German or English ✓ Proof of language proficiency required for admission: Level B2 or C1 (<i>Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, CEFR</i>) depending on the language of instruction and respective requirements of the selected Bachelor's degree programme at Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt <p>The complete application documents for the admission must be submitted electronically to alpenadria.grants@aau.at by 31.07.2019.</p> <p>Please note that incomplete applications will not be taken into consideration.</p>
<p>Further Information</p>	<p>Scholarship holders can book accommodation in a student residence via the OeAD Housing Office.
